THE PLEISTOCENE FLORA FROM KROŚCIENKO n/D. IN SOUTHERN POLAND

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New material was collected from the brickyard in Krościenko where the famous Pleistocene flora of W. Szafer originated [1].

It was collected with the purpose of palynological and macroscopic plant analyses. 14 samples to macroanalyse and 82 to sporomorphs analyse were taken under Prof. K. Birkenmajer's direction in 1988. The correlation with some layers of the deposits from the upper part of the profile revealed in 1956 will be done. The results will be published after the completion of the whole material.
