Congress of Chemical Technology is an organised every three years forum of exchange of ideas and scientific outputs of Polish chemical technologists, academic and industrial staff. Series of Congresses has been started in 1994, on the 1<sup>st</sup> Congress in Szczecin and continued on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congress in Wrocław, in 1997.

The goal of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Congress is a reflection on the up-to-now achievements of Polish chemical technology as well as an outline of desired directions of development of this science. The newest achievements in all areas of chemical technology, with regard to scientific investigations and their implementations in the chemical and related industries will be presented on the Congress.
